Capri's most iconic attraction are the Faraglioni: an unmissable sight for any fortunate visitor who stands in awe of its grandeur.

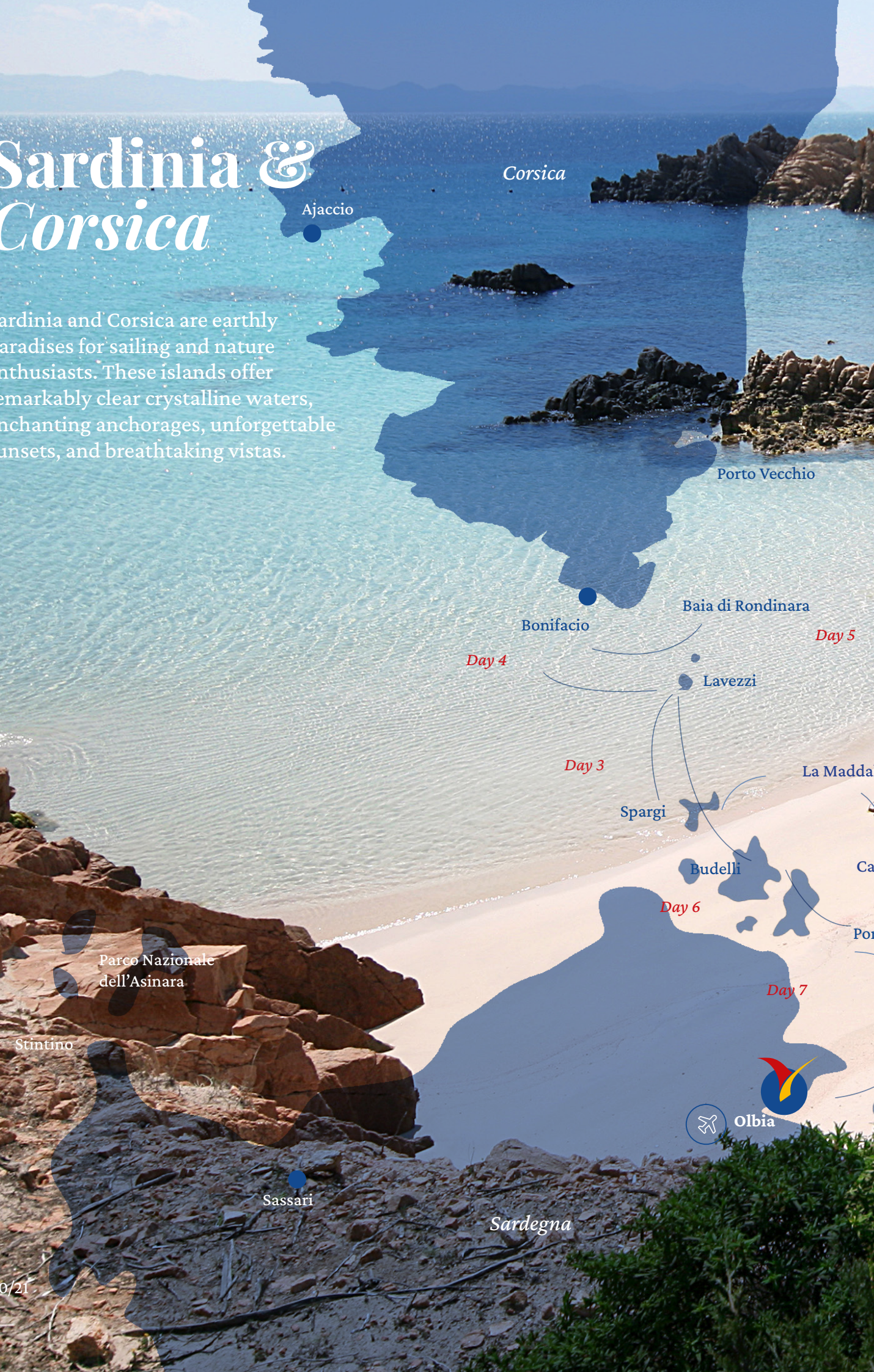

Sardinia, with its breathtaking beaches and crystal-clear waters, is undoubtedly one of the most sought-after summer tourist destinations in the world. Just a little over an hour's boat ride from the base of Olbia, you can reach the most beautiful bays of the Maddalena Archipelago and the white cliffs of the enchanting city of Bonifacio in Corsica.

Countless wonders await you: from the island of Caprera, with its Cala Coticcio - the Sardinian "Tahiti" - to Spargi, the third-largest island in the National Park of the Archipelago, which will treat you to a dive into the pristine waters of Cala Granara and Cala Corsara. Sailing towards Bonifacio, you'll encounter the island of Lavezzi, a small gem studded with beaches and emerging rocks, declared a protected nature reserve where the wild and unspoiled nature will enchant you. The Bay of Rondinara is another must-see destination to explore: a small bay nestled between two promontories covered in Mediterranean scrub, with white sands and crystal-clear turquoise waters. Returning to Sardinia, numerous captivating sights await: essential pit stops include the three "sister" islands of Razzoli, Santa Maria, and Budelli – with its iconic Pink Beach – which are reachable only by sea.

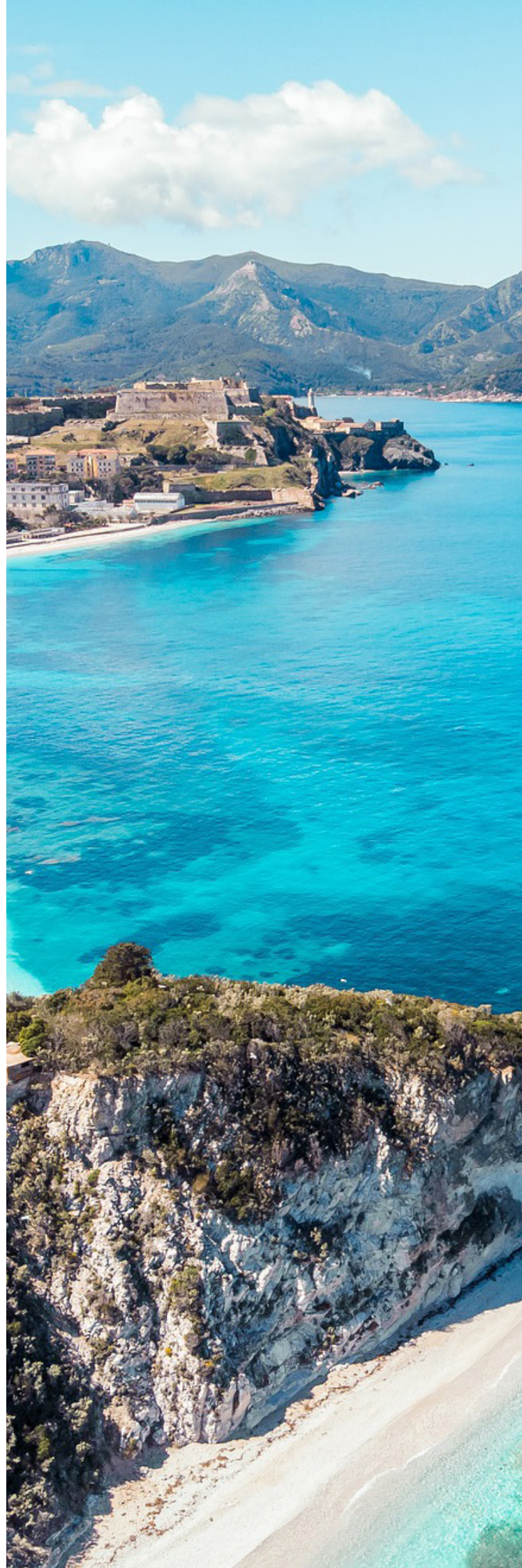

Tuscan Archipelago

The Tuscan Archipelago boasts enchanting villages, cultural pathways that link the coastal and inland regions, scenery sculpted by grand cliffs molded by the wind, dotted with sandy shores and lush Mediterranean vegetation.

Ponza, the main island of the Pontine Archipelago, enchants with its numerous coves, bays, rocky and sandy beaches, and underwater caves, making it an invaluable destination for snorkeling enthusiasts. Upon arrival, the village offers a unique spectacle: a cluster of houses with flat pastel-colored roofs perched above a quay that crosses the harbor. A land of Greeks and Romans, Ponza hosts significant archaeological legacies, such as Roman necropolises, imperial villas, and cisterns scattered around the island.

The coasts of Ponza harbor incredible beauties. From the Turtle Rock, three natural pools can be reached: an absolute must-see. Chiaia di Luna, accessible only by sea, is the most famous beach, along with the lively Frontone beach and Bagno Vecchio. Ventotone, a small gem of the archipelago, is a splendid natural reserve with a few houses gathered around the harbor and an ancient history. Palmarola, the westernmost and uninhabited of the Pontine Islands, is wild, secluded, and unspoiled. Of volcanic origin, Palmarola has seen nature prevail over time: a few walkable paths, immersed in lush vegetation including dwarf palms, which give the island its name, overlooking calm, emerald-green waters.

Aegadian Islands

The Aegadian Islands archipelago is a vibrant yet unspoiled tourist destination. Each island has its own unique characteristics, but they all share the same irresistible crystal-clear waters that surround their Marine Reserve, one of the largest and most diverse in Europe.



Favignana, the largest and most populous of the archipelago, is renowned for its crystalline azure waters and unique bays such as Cala Rossa. Breathtaking limestone cliffs cascade into the cobalt blue sea, while mountain trails offer wonderful walks.

Marettimo is a true hideaway, preserved from tourism and untouched in both its waters and terrestrial nature. Marettimo's coastline holds great allure, featuring numerous marine caves piercing the towering dolomite cliffs by the sea, like the Grotta del Cammello, which houses a pebble beach and the remains of a Roman settlement.

Levanzo, the smallest of the islands, is a hilly islet with a coastline primarily composed of sheer rocky cliffs that hide dreamy beaches. Everything here is essential yet charming: there's only one village – Cala Dogana – one road, two shops, two hotels, and two restaurants. Peace and tranquility are guaranteed, and the frantic pace of the city quickly becomes a distant memory.
